

60% of the total cost to buy and operate a printer is in service and toner cartridges.

Why should you care?

40% – 60% of most IT helpdesk calls are printer related.

50/50 is the typical ratio of color vs black and white print volumes in most offices.

If your business needs to print color documents such as proposals or client presentations, you may want an alternative to expensive printer brand-name cartridges.

70% of empty printer cartridges go directly to the landfill when they could be recycled.

Acquiring a Printer

The average price of a commercial grade office printer ranges from \$250 to \$10,000. This, of course, depends on your print volumes which tend to determine the size and speed of the print engine. Regardless of price, there are 3 ways to acquire a business printer.

Finance a Printer

Some businesses lease printers to lessen the up-front purchase price by spreading the cost of the printer over 3-5 years, similar to cell phone companies. A lease is an operating expense with tax benefits.



You know your office needs the best to run the best.


Here are the most popular features and why.

- √ Scanning converts paper documents to digital files

- ✓ **Automatic Duplexing** prints on both sides of a piece of paper.

- ✓ **Ledger Paper Tray** option to print on 11 x 17 inch paper. Note: only 2% of office printing is done on ledger size paper and this capability can push the cost of the printer up significantly.
- ✓ **Energy Saver Mode** allows printer to conserve energy consumption during off peak hours.
- ✓ **Fax** the ability to scan and transmit documents when / if a copy is required.
