


## How to Turn Off HP® Printer Firmware Updates

HP<sup>®</sup> printers are designed to periodically receive updates. These updates are for various fixes and improvements; however, some are designed to prevent the use of third-party cartridges. In order to prevent this happening, and to allow you to continue to use Cartridge World cartridges, we recommend you do the following on your printer:

#### 1. New Firmware Version Detected

The following will appear automatically on your printer and will prompt you to update the firmware


## Switch off HP Firmware Updates


